Where Writewiz fits in 5+3+3+4

01

Foundational (Nursery–Class 2): grip, posture, patterns, early letters and numbers

02

Preparatory (Class 3–5): sentences, paragraphs, neat notebooks, basic diagrams

03

Middle (Class 6–8): long answers, diagrams, maths and science layouts

04

Secondary (Class 9–10): exam-speed writing and clear answer-sheet presentation

Whole-school model

One curriculum for the entire school, not scattered copywriting books.



Teacher-led

Your own teachers implement Writewiz after short, focused training.



Measured change

Before/after samples, book reviews, and class visit reports each term.

How Writewiz fits into your timetable



Period plan

Writewiz runs like any other subject on your timetable. Schools usually offer 1–2 periods per week for each class. Many partner schools simply trim 5 minutes from regular periods, or slightly advance the morning bell and extend the closing bell, so that core subjects continue without disruption.

Model A

2 periods per week for core Writewiz classes (usually KG–8)

Model B

1 period per week with short daily practice inside subject periods

Model C

Foundation focus for Classes 1–3, maintenance plan for Classes 4–8

Inside a typical Writewiz period

- Quick posture, pencil grip, and book position check
- Guided practice using Writewiz student modules
- Short demonstration by the teacher using the board
- Targeted correction of letter formation, spacing, and alignment
- 2–3 minutes of speed and presentation practice for exam answers

We do not leave teachers alone with a book

- Start-of-year training for all Writewiz teachers
- Practice sheets and correction aids for teachers
